

Modern Day Slavery and Human Trafficking Policy Statement

This policy applies to Aran Group companies including Aran Insulation Limited and Aran Energy Funding Limited (the Company).

The Company acknowledges the provisions of the Modern Day Slavery Act 2015. The Company also acknowledges that is exempt from the "Transparency in Supply Chain" provisions to publish an annual statement as its annual turnover is not above the threshold (£36 million). However, the Company will ensure transparency within the organisation and with suppliers of good and services to the organisation.

The Company is satisfied from its own due diligence there is no evidence of any act of modern day slavery or human trafficking within the organisation or supply chain. As part of the Company's due diligence process into slavery and human trafficking the Company's supplier approval process incorporates a review of the controls undertaken by the supplier.

The Company will not knowingly support or deal with any business involved in slavery or human trafficking.

The Company will undertake responsibility for implementing this Policy Statement and its objectives.
