Cambridgeshire Green Deal Communities Grant Funding

Mr lyer and Miss Husmann both live in Cambridgeshire in a pre-1929 home built with a solid brick construction. Most houses built in the UK before 1930 were constructed with solid brick walls, making them unsuitable for standard cavity wall insulation

They wanted to improve the thermal comfort of their home. After making contact with Cambridge City Council they were advised that they could benefit from a Green Deal Communities grant which allows residents to claim up to **£7,000 towards energy saving home improvements**.

A Green Deal assessment and Energy Performance Certification was carried out which indicated External Wall Insulation as a recommended measure to improve the energy performance of their dwelling, saving them up to $\pounds460^*$ a year off their fuel bills every year.

Aran Services installed External Wall Insulation using an SPS Envirowall System with 90mm of EPS. The install came complete with an industry backed <u>25 year guarantee</u>.
